

TEACHING METHODOLOGY AND ASSESSMENT

The programme content has been designed in simple English language, keeping in mind following two aspects:

- A) It must cover important management principles imbibed in each subject.
- B) It must narrate real time relevant experiences of practical value, providing examples that impart learning on problem solving.

Considering that candidates may have limitations on hours to devote to studies, only selectively important and relevant teaching material has been included in each chapter.

We shall be providing with **hard copy of one book** on each subject. Over and above this, **a DVD shall be provided** that will contain recorded lectures by the respective faculty member covering the salient points in each chapter as also providing an aeroplane view of the sum and substance of each chapter. We shall **follow trimester system**. During these three months, students need to invest about an hour everyday. They shall have the **facility to seek answer to any question** that they may have and such a correspondence can happen through E-mail. **A full-fledged system has been developed to address the query resolve system through E-mail.**

Assessment: -

As mentioned before, we have adopted trimester system. During these three months period, participants shall be evaluated on the basis of:

- a) Two quizzes
- b) One assignment
- c) One mid term exam
- d) One final exam
- e) One term project

The above schedule implies that it requires regular efforts of two years on your part. Those students who do not expect to devote on an average an hour a day may avoid taking admission to this programme.

Academic committee shall be constrained to cancel the admission of a student who fails consecutively in two trimesters.

Physical Interaction: -

Each student shall be advised to complete one management project in each term. All students shall be invited to one common location at the end of each trimester to present the findings. They will be assessed by an expert pannel & feedback on improvements, if any, shall be provided. This will provide an opportunity to students to interact among each other as also with the expert pannel.
